

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF
INSTITUTE FOR NARCOTICS STUDY AND ANALYSIS

1. Name of the Society : INSTITUTE FOR NARCOTICS STUDY AND ANALYSIS
2. Location of Registered Office : The office of the Society shall remain in the NCT of Delhi. At present it is located at D-1008, New Friends Colony, New Delhi.
3. Area of Operation : NCT of Delhi
4. Aims & Objects : The aims & objects for which the Society is established are as under:

(i) Main Objects:

- a. To act as an apolitical, independent and academic organisation for narcotics study and analysis.
- b. To conduct research on impact of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances on public health.
- c. To promote and conduct research on the development of the current global policies concerning narcotics from a broad inter-disciplinary perspective including social, cultural and economic aspects.
- d. To serve as a centre for promoting expression of free, frank and unbiased deliberations and discussions on all matters relating to narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances amongst research scholars, experts, policy makers, bureaucrats, health workers, NGOs and institutions in India and abroad.
- e. To undertake projects and/or activities with a view to assisting development of the best practices and policies relating to narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances.
- f. To make available results of study and analysis conducted by the Society to the concerned international and regional organisations, governments, public health departments and regulatory authorities for appropriate changes in policy framework towards better public health, prevention of drug trafficking and associated security issues.

(ii) Incidental Objects:

- a. To assist study centres, universities and other institutions for imparting training to students.
- b. To grant endowment at universities, research institutions and other educational, medical and scientific institutions for spread of education and knowledge.

- c. To award scholarships and fellowships on such terms and conditions as the Governing Board may think proper.
 - d. To periodically publish a journal and other publications to disseminate research findings and opinions of informed scholars.
 - e. To collaborate, and join other national and international institutions/organisations carrying on similar activities on case to case basis.
 - f. To amalgamate or merge with any other institution or society having similar objects.
 - g. To carry out any other drug related charitable activity as the Governing Board may think proper.
4. All the income, earnings (including amount received by way of sale of know how, premium and royalty, fee charged for a research project) moveable, immovable properties of the Society shall be solely utilised and applied towards promotion of its aims and objectives only as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or any manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the Society or to any person claiming through anyone or more of the present or past members. No member of the Society shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the Society or make any profit whatsoever by virtue of its membership.
